

**Statement of the Facts:**

1. The appellant filed RTI Petition dated 15<sup>th</sup> Jan 2013 before the respondent to seek the information regarding – List of students (from Delhi) to whom minority scholarships (Pre Metric, Post Metric and Merit cum Means) were granted, rejected and kept pending. Few more information are sought like Utilization Certificate, Review Reports, etc. For ready reference, copy of the RTI application is enclosed herewith.
2. Respondent referred to visit the website and download the list of students to whom scholarships are awarded during the financial year 201-11 and 2011-12. On the website ONLY the list of students receiving scholarships in Govt. Aided Private schools is uploaded. There are no lists of students of MCD schools and in Secondary/Higher Secondary schools which is needed by the appellant.
3. Respondent has not provided the list of students who applied but got rejected for whatever reasons. This information is essential for the appellant to understand the reasons for rejection and develop recommendations to assist the Government and the beneficiaries in improving the delivery and access to these scholarships.
4. Respondent has not furnished the copy of utilization certificate which is a public document.
5. Respondent has not furnished any information regarding the review reports and audit reports of the fund disbursed.
6. Respondent has not exercised the power under section 6(3) of RTI Act 2005 to transfer the application to the concerned responsible official(s) who are custodian of the information sought. Since the Ministry is the first authority to disburse fund, it must be certainly be aware that to whom they have disbursed and for what purposes. Also, to ask them to furnish the required records which the appellant needs.
7. Paragraph 17 of the guidelines of Post Metric Scholarship (MONITORING & TRANSPARENCY) empowers the respondent to warrant for physical and financial progress reports. Similar provision like evaluation, monitoring, review, etc are made in other guidelines also. It means, respondent is well aware of the fact that who are responsible but he has not transferred the application under section 6(3). It may also be noted that physical and financial progress does not mean and limited to the meaning he is referring in his letter.

**Appeal**

**Therefore, the First Appellate Authority is appealed hereby very humbly to direct the respondents and order them to furnish the information sought or transfer the application to concerned responsible CPIOs. The students whose applications have been rejected or are pending is not available in the Ministry. The Scholarship applications are called by States/UTs and only proposal of recommended students is sent to this Ministry for release of grant in aid as per the Physical target of the concerned States/UTs. Hence, the list of students who could not be awarded Scholarship for any reason may be availed from Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi. These informations are not available in/maintained by the Ministry.
2. **Tarraqi I Foundation** is committed to scaling and strengthening qualitative education and skills development for the disadvantaged communities and peace building by strengthening respect and trust between communities through informal outreach programmes like sports, life skills camps etc.

Recently, Tarraqi I Foundation has undertaken a **Research study** along with the Centre for Civil Society titled, "**Assessing access to GoI Minority Scholarships Schemes and mapping the way forward**". The aim of this Research is to assess minority community's access to scholarship schemes, the efficiency with which they are administered, understand community experiences comparing it to the relevant SC/ST/OBC scholarship schemes and suggest recommendations for the way forward.. This is with reference to the appeal dated 26/2/2013 filed by Sh. Amir Abidi R/o.141, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor Opposite Jain Mandir, Masoodpur Vasant Kunj, New Delhi-110070 before the First Appellate Authority u/s 19 of the RTI Act, 2005 stating therein that the Public Information Officer has not furnished the information as asked for vide RTI application dated 15/1/2013.

2. I have examined the appeal as well as reply furnished by Public Information Officer, vide ID No: 961. On the date of hearing fixed on 28/3/2013 the appellant could not appear. However, on the merit of the case following decisions are taken. In so far as the first question about the list of students whose applications have been approved, rejected or pending under the Pre-Matric, Post Matric and Merit Cum Scholarship of Minority students for the year 2009-10, 2010-11, 2011-12, and 2012-13, this is a scheme operated by the Department itself. Hence, the information as applied for may be furnished to the appellant.

3. As regards the applications relating to SC/ST/OBC students, the scheme is being implemented by various Departments like Education, Higher Education, DTTE etc the complete information may not be immediately available in the Department; hence it will be advisable for the appellant to approach the Departments concerned. Similarly the utilization certificate in respect of the said schemes will be available with the Departments concerned. As regards the review report for the periods mentioned above, a formal review has not been carried out and same is yet to be available. Similarly is the case of the Audit report for the said period is yet to be available

4. Accordingly the appeal is partially allowed as discussed above.






