## SUBJECT COACHING FOR EXCELLENCE

The main objective of coaching at TGC is to provide students with good conceptual clarity and skills to excel in Board & Competitive Exams. Our competent and energetic faculty uses audio/visual learning tools, conducts mock tests and gives engaging worksheets. We strive to give individualised attention, as required, to every student. Students can also access online learning sources at the centre.

**2015-16:** Coaching at TGC Mewat, started in almost the last quarter of the academic session. Priya Rathore and Ankur Kumar passed their exams with distinction. At TGC Tonk, three students - Akshat Jain, Kaishav & Aman scored above 80% marks overall. Umama scored 100% marks in English in Class 10<sup>th</sup> Board Exams.

**2016-17:** Number of students and the results have improved significantly. At both the centres, most of the students passed their Board Exams with distinction, many scoring over 80% and two students from Mewat TGC, Mohd. Ashfaq and Parvez scored 95% marks in Physics.

**2017-18:** Number of students and the results have improved significantly. At both the centres, most of the students passed their Board Exams with distinction, many scoring over 80%. At TGC Tonk, two students Javvad Qamar, M. Fazil Khan scored above 91% marks in Maths in 12<sup>th</sup> Board Exams. From Mewat TGC, Waseem Khan, scored 92% marks in Physics and 90% marks in Chemistry.

## HIGHER EDUCATION COACHING & SUPPORT PROGRAMS

To be a bridge between students from backward areas and nationally renowned educational organizations is on one of the five core areas of TGC. We conduct community awareness and student counseling sessions to prepare students for specialist coaching centres like Rahmani 30, Jamia Hamdard, etc. or for entrance exams for institutions like A.M.U, J.M.I, Navodya Vidhalya, etc. In 2016, 2 students from Tonk: S. Uzair Ahmed qualified for IIT-JEE batch; and Sayed Abdullah Hasan, for the AIMPT (NEET). One student from Mewat: Mohammad Afzal qualified for AIMPT (NEET). They are now undergoing coaching at the Rahmani Super 30 Coaching Centre, Patna.

In 2017, total 7 students (4 students from Tonk & 3 student from Mewat) participated in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Phase written exam held at Rahmani30, Patna. Three students from Tonk: Afeera Razi - qualified for AIMPT (NEET) batch; Durraiz Khan, for the IIT-JEE batch for Aurangabad (Maharashtra); and Mohammad Anas for AIMPT (NEET) batch.

## CAREER GUIDANCE & EDUCATIONAL AWARENESS PROGRAMS

1) 'Career Yatra' was organised consistently in 2015, 2016 and 2017, both in Tonk and Mewat, wherein almost 300-400 students participated in each workshop, facilitated by nationally renowned Career Counselor, Mr. Ameen e Muddasir, CEO-CIGMA, Bangalore.

2) TGC organises Engineering (IIT-JEE) & Medical (NEET) preparatory courses for Rahmani30, Hamdard Coaching Centre; Defense Services at Anees Classes, Pune; Civil Services at Jamia Hamdard Coaching etc. 10 students have been selected so far.

3) IIT JEE Workshop were conducted in Mewat by Mr. Arish Inam, Sr. Faculty-PACE IITians, Mumbai (IIT Kharagpur).



4) Multiple Intelligence and Experiential Education Workshops are regularly facilitated by Mr. Amir Abidi, Director Tarraqi I Foundation.

5) Annual e-CUBATE Workshops focusing on Memory Building, Study skills & Motivation are conducted by Mr. Ameen e Mudassar, CEO-CIGMA & Memory.

6) Defense Services career workshop were conducted by Air Vice Marshall Razzaqui Retd (AVSM), Group Captain Anwar, Col. Jafri at TGC, Nuh and in Tonk by Major Anwar Khan Sb.



7) Haryana State Level Education Conference was organised in Nuh in partnership with Millat Foundation (MFERD) and attended by almost 400 delegates. Similarly, Punjab State Conference was organised in Maler Kotla, wherein almost 700 delegates attended.

9) The TGC Computer Centre was inaugurated in Nuh by Shri Mani Ram Sharma IAS, DC-Tonk and in Tonk, by Dr. Suraj Singh Negi, SDM-Tonk.

10) A seminar on "Science of Learning and Teaching in the 21st Century" was facilitated by Dr. Qazi Siraj Azher, Associate Clinical Professor at Michigan, State University, U.S.A.

## SPREAD TARRAQI (Progress) – SUPPORT TGC

TGCs have been running with the support of IMEFNA and community donors. A moderate coaching fee is charged from students who take regular subject coaching. Many students from poor families are unable to pay the fee and their cost is covered by student sponsorship program. TGC has a basic operational budget of Rs. 2 lac per month per centre. You could contribute by donations and volunteering to support the TGC efforts. You could fund the entire operational cost for a year or for a monthly cost. Donors wishing to sponsor the full Centre expenses can contact us. We will be sending monthly updates and quarterly reports to the donors. Indian Nationals can gain 50% tax benefit for their donations as TiF has 12A/80G certification.

### STUDENT SPONSORSHIP AND TGC SCHOLARSHIP FUND

We are committed that no deserving student should lose out on the opportunity to get coaching at TGC or at other specialist coaching centres like Jamia Hamdard etc., due to lack of funds. **The needy students apply for sponsorship by filling up a form which is validated by a 3 member team.** One such example is of **Syed Afreen Jahan, Class 12<sup>th</sup> topper (Hindi medium) from Tonk** who had scored 84%. She had qualified the **Jamia Hamdard NEET coaching** program but was unable to afford the amount of **Rs. 87,400/-, the cost of one year boarding and lodging, since her father, a weaver by profession, earned hardly Rs 4000/- per month.**
