

Report: Dr. Hyder Mohammad Khan's (Trustee, IMEFNA) visit to the Tarraqi Guidance & Information Network (GAIN) Centres in Mewat & Tonk

Visit to Tarraqi GAIN Centre, Mewat on 23rd Feb 2016, Tuesday

Dr. Hyder Mohammad Khan visited TGC Mewat on 23rd February 2016. He observed the coaching of Class 10th students and thereby gave them a pep talk for the upcoming Boards exams. He also had discussions with some youth, parents, teachers and community/education leaders like Maulana Sher Mohammad Amini, Mr. Hasan (Al Hasan School), Mr. Khalid (Mewat Modern Academy), etc. about the educational needs of the students in Mewat. Opening of more GAIN centres in Mewat, teacher training and support to develop qualitative education, computer training, english communication skills and financial support and guidance for higher education of meritorious students were the major needs expressed by the group. He appreciated the efforts of the TGC team and the community's support especially the centre venue provided by the Mewat Development Agency (MDA). He inquired about the computer education and internet support to students and was assured that this will start next month. He took keen interest in understanding the administrative processes and gave useful advice to further develop the centre.

Visit to Tarraqi GAIN Centre, Tonk on 24th Feb 2016, Wednesday

Dr. Hyder Mohammad Khan (Trustee, IMEFNA) visited the Tarraqi GAIN Centre in Tonk on 24th February. He observed the classes and had an interactive session with Class 9th & 10th students, where among other things he also asked students about their career ambitions. Besides doctors, engineers and teachers, there were aspiring lawyers, journalists, army men and a CID officer too. Later, Dr. Hyder had a discussion with some teachers, education and community leaders of Tonk such as Ms. Najma Naseem, Mrs. & Mr. Khursheed Anwar, Mrs. & Mr. Maulana Amir Siddiqui Sb., Mr. Adnan Khan, Mr. Tahir Khan, etc. Earlier, he had met Major Anwar Sb., an ardent educationist, and had visited the Girls Madarsa and vocational centre in Baheer, being run under the care of Maulana Amir Sb. He later visited one of the vocational cum study centres being supported by the Tarraqi I Foundation (TiF) and was overwhelmed by the case studies of many girls/women who had started or revived their education after going through severe harassment/abuse in marriage/divorce. He was concerned to note that as the Tarraqi Project, under which these centres were running, has ended, these centres may not sustain much further. He has urged TiF to ensure that these centers continue and develop further and promised



support/guidance. We are planning on linking these women with designers/buyers so that they can earn and build their lives further. We are also striving to continue these centres where other than the vocational skills, the women are also encouraged to enroll in NIOS or Rajasthan Board Pvt. Exams to continue/ revive their studies. Their children as well as other out of school and/or drop out kids are given support to cover their learning gaps before admitting them to nearby schools/madarsas. After school tuition support is also given to the vulnerable kids.
